

Chocolate Sampler Quilt Along

Block 7 – Diamond in a Square



Feature Fabric	A	(2) – 12 ½ " x 12 ½ " squares
Light Fabric	B	(8) – 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares

Before Starting:

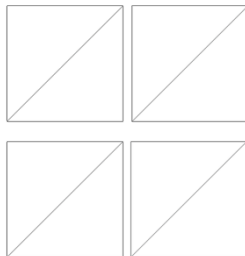
- Seam allowance: Scant ¼"
- Press as arrows indicate throughout
- Assumption using same fabric for both blocks
- Read the entire pattern before starting

Abbreviations:

RST – Right Sides Together

Piecing Instructions:

Assemble Units

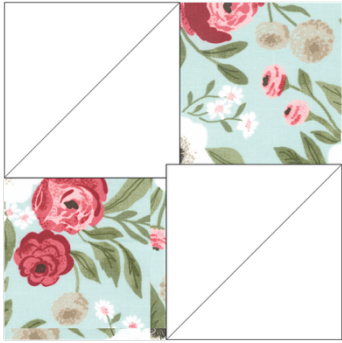


1. Gather 1 Fabric A square and (4) Fabric B squares.

2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on each Fabric B squares.

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3. Pin a Fabric B RST to opposite corners of Fabric A. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Repeat for on opposite corners.

Tip: Sewing just off the line closest to the outside corner provides space for the thread when you flip the fabric out.



4. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each sew line.



5. Open and press seams to the lighter fabric.



6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make a second block.

Unfinished size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
